

Three Over Four

Or A Pair Of Threequarter Hoses

A two couple Strathspey in a $\frac{3}{4}$ four couple set

1- 8 $\frac{3}{4}$ Rights and Lefts

1-2 1st couple cross right hand

3-4 1s and 2s cross left on the sides

5-6 1s and 2s cross right ; 1s just about $\frac{3}{4}$, staying back to back in the middle facing own side.

7-8 1s set while 2s dance down the sidelines finishing facing 1s in a line of 4 across the dance (2nd Man faces 1st Lady, 2nd Lady 1st Man).

16 – 24: $\frac{3}{4}$ Reel of Four

All dance 6 bars of a Reel of Four, on bar 7-8 2nd Man and 1st Lady change places (1st Lady dances above 2nd Lady, 2nd Man, pulling right shoulder back, below her). Meanwhile, 2nd Lady and 1st Man may turn single on the spot or just wait two bars. At the end 2nd Lady and 1st Man face up, 2nd Man and 1st Lady face down, 1s are on the men's side, 2s on the ladies' side slightly above 2nd place.

17–24 1s and 2s dance the Targe:

Ladies turn left hand $\frac{3}{4}$, while Men chase one place counterclockwise, all turn partner once, repeat finishing in the sidelines (1s are on the men's side, 1st Man in top place, 2s on the Ladies' side, 2nd Lady in top place)

25 – 28 all dance $\frac{3}{4}$ Right Hand Across, 1s are in 2nd place on own sides, 2s in top place on opposite sides.

29-32 all 3 couples set, 2s cross over giving right hand, 1s and 3s change on the sides, left hand on the Ladies' side, right hand on men's side.

For a normal two couple dance, 1s dance a right hand turn on bar 31-32, starting again in 2nd place,
